## Supporting Ethnic/Cultural Events to Promote Vaccination in MN



Project HEALINGS was created as a HUB for improved health and wellness among Minnesotans disenfranchised by identity and circumstance, facing disparities in both healthcare access and health outcomes, and impacted disproportionately by the COVID-19 pandemic.

HEALINGS is about vaccination, but it is also about connectivity, trust, and systemic change designed intentionally to end inequities for Black, Indigenous, and other persons of color (BIPOC) living here in Minnesota.

### Eligibility

All BIPOC Community-based Groups hosting cultural events where vaccine information and education is provided are welcome to apply.

### Awards

Up to \$2,000 of event funding can be requested for ethnic and cultural events where vaccine information and education is provided. Awards will be made monthly until funding is depleted.

### Submission

Requests for upcoming events are due by the 15th of the month for consideration. Applicants will receive notice by the 21st of the month. One grant will be provided per community-based group.
