Incentives to Mobilize Individuals to get Vaccinated in MN

Project HEALINGS was created as a HUB for improved health and wellness among Minnesotans disenfranchised by identity and circumstance, facing disparities in both healthcare access and health outcomes, and impacted disproportionately by the COVID-19 pandemic.

HEALINGS is about vaccination, but it is also about connectivity, trust, and systemic change designed intentionally to end inequities for Black, Indigenous, and other persons of color (BIPOC) living here in Minnesota.

Eligibility

All BIPOC Community-based Groups encouraging vaccination are all welcome to apply

Awards

Up to \$2,000 of funding for purchase of individual incentives such as gift cards can be requested for ethnic and cultural population groups participating in vaccination clinics.

Awards will be made monthly until funding is depleted.

Submission

Requests for funding are **due by the 1st of the month for consideration.** Applicants will receive notice by the 7st of the month. One grant will be provided per community-based group.
